

I-80 West Reno Bridge Replacements

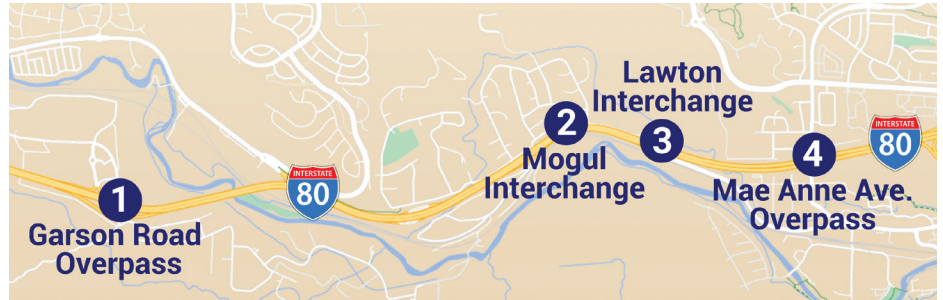


Project Overview

To help ensure public safety and the preservation of the state's bridges, NDOT evaluates and identifies bridges for replacement. As bridges in our community age, the older structures need to be replaced to ensure public safety. This project, on I-80 west of Reno, will replace seven bridge structures, prioritized by the State of Nevada based on age and condition.

This project includes the reconstruction of the following seven bridges at four locations along I-80:

- Garson Road Overpass
- I-80 East/West at Mogul Interchange (2 Bridges)
- I-80 East/West at Lawton Interchange (2 Bridges)
- I-80 East/West at Mae Anne Avenue Overpass (2 Bridges)



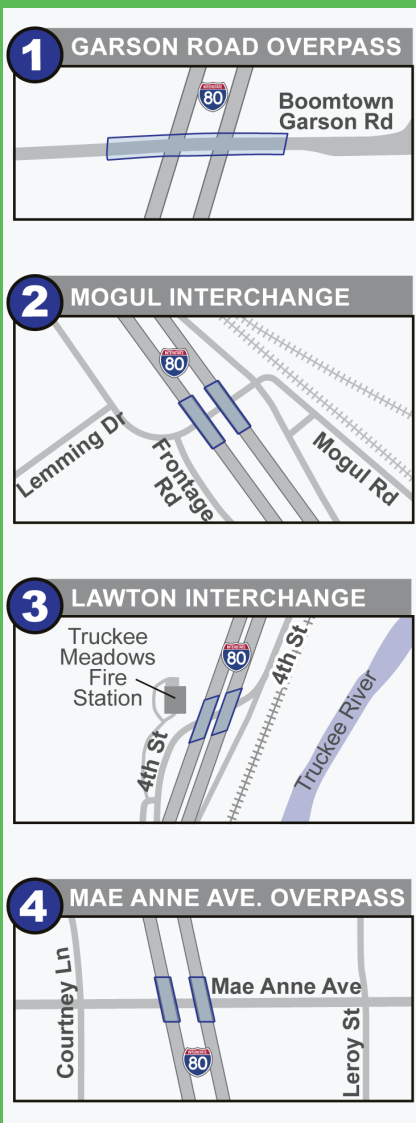
Construction Details

Project construction began in April 2025 and is anticipated for completion in December 2028. Q&D Construction is the general contractor.

- At least two lanes of traffic will remain open in each direction during the daytime.
- Nighttime traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction.
- Traffic shifts and crossovers will take place.
- Reduced speed limit to 55 MPH.
- Short-term detours may occur as bridge sections are demolished and reconstructed.
- Drivers should be prepared for moderate travel delays.
- Weather conditions may impact construction schedule.

Funding

This project represents a nearly **\$68 million investment** in our region. Approximately 95% of the total cost is federally funded specifically to replace the bridges for the approximately 47,000 who travel the interstate every day.
